## COMBAT AVIATION ADVISOR (CAA)

Combat Aviation Advisors are Air Commandos responsible for the conduct of special operations activities by, with, and through foreign aviation forces.

## MISSION

CAAs are tasked to carry out Foreign Internal Defense (FID), Security Force Assistance (SFA) and unconventional warfare (UW) missions on behalf of USSOCOM.

## CAPABILITIES

CAAs are trained in a wide range of specialized skills that they use to carry out SOF Mobility, ISR, Adaptive Strike and Agile Surface Integration. When directed, USSOCOM employs mission-tailored CAA Operational Aviation Detachments to support combatant commanders' regional objectives.
