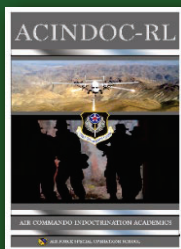

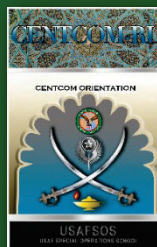


(U) Air Commando Indoctrination Academics - RL (W119)

Dates: Self-paced: 5-25 Apr, 1-23 May, 1-20 Jun

Duration: Self Paced (18 hrs)
Collaborate (1 day)

Audience: New to AFSOC or personnel requiring knowledge of US Special Ops
Description: Intro to Special Ops, Cultural Competencies, and Joint Planning Process



(U) CENTCOM Orientation – RL (T119)

Duration: 4 days

Audience: SOF personnel who support operations in CENTCOM AOR

Description: Focuses on US strategic interests, as well as theater history and culture. **Required as prerequisite to T218 CENTCOM Theater Operations course.**

Duration: Self-Paced (10 hrs)

Audience: Personnel tasked to support JSOAC or other SOF C2 node but not actively engaged in C2

(U) INDOPACOM Orientation – RL (T129)

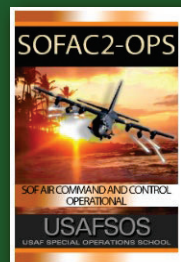
Dates: 26-29 Apr

Audience: SOF personnel who support operations in INDOPACOM AOR

Description: Focuses on US strategic interests, as well as theater history and culture. **Required as prerequisite to T228 INDOPACOM Theater Operations course.**

(S) SOF Air Command and Control Operations (W221)

Dates: 4-6 May, 25-27 May (HRT/CVS)

Duration: 4.5 days

Pre-requisite: W129

Audience: Personnel tasked to a JSOAC or other SOF C2 node actively engaged in C2, operations planning, or ops execution.

Description: SOF C2 Operations, Orders of Battle, OPLANs/CONPLANs



(U) EUCOM Orientation – RL (T139)

Dates: 17-20 May

Duration: 4 days

Audience: SOF personnel who support operations in EUCOM AOR

Description: Focuses on US strategic interests as well as theater history and culture. **Required as prerequisite to T238 EUCOM Theater Operations course.**



(S) SOF Mission Command (W231)

Dates: 13-15 Apr (HRT/Mildenhall), 18-20 May, 22-24 Jun (HRT/CVS/Kadena)

Duration: 3 days

Audience: AFSOF selected to serve as Mission Commander or Team Sergeant/SEL

Description: Military operations seminar designed to prepare AFSOC MC/SEs for detachment/team command.



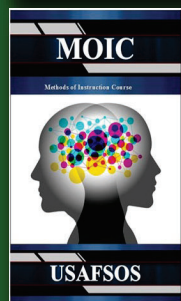
(U) AFRICOM Orientation – RL (T149)

Audience: SOF personnel who support operations in the AFRICOM AOR

Description: Focuses on US strategic interests, as well as theater history and culture. **Required as prerequisite to T248 AFRICOM Theater Operations course.**



(U) Methods of Instruction Course (MOIC) 10 days, 3 credit hrs

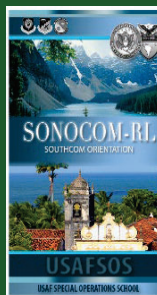
Dates: 10-21 May

(U) MOI-Academics Course (MOIAC)

1-month online, 2 credit hrs

Dates: 1-30 Apr, 1-30 Jun

Audience: AFSOC and SOF instructors to develop and teach curriculum, and create active learning environments focused on higher levels of learning through the use of various teaching methodologies.



(U) SOUTH/NORTHCOM Orientation-RL (T159)

Dates: 12-15 Apr

Duration: 4 days

Audience: SOF personnel who support operations in the SOUTHCOM and NORTHCOM AORs

Description: Focuses on US strategic interests in both AORs grounded in cultural and historical knowledge of both theaters. **Required as prerequisite to T258 SONOCOM Theater Operations course.**

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Remote Learning (RL)?

Remote learning takes place online and utilizes cloud-enabled technology to deliver education. Flexible schedules allow students learn at their own pace through self-directed activities and assignments, and live web-based discussions offer the opportunity for students to interact with their peers and instructors from the convenience of their own homes.

What is On-Demand Remote Learning?

On-demand learning utilizes the same cloud-based infrastructure as remote learning to accommodate the immediate need for education. Self-paced lessons and a wide variety of resources are easily accessible and available 24/7.

What is Face-2-Face (F2F) Learning?

Face-to-face is the traditional method of instruction where students attend a course at a brick and mortar school.

What do I need to take RL courses?

Register for the courses via <https://afsoc.blackboard.com/>

Most of our content is accessible from either government or commercial Internet. To join live web-based sessions or view YouTube videos, commercial internet is required. You will need a device (laptop, smartphone, desktop, tablet) with a microphone and a camera.

What systems does USAFSOS use for RL?

USAFSOS's primary learning management system is Blackboard Learn and the full suite of complementary tools and programs to include Blackboard Collaborate. The Blackboard Collaborate platform offers an immersive educational experience and human interaction through live web-based instruction from your personal device.
