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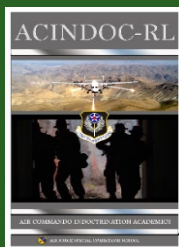

(U) Air Commando Indoctrination Academics - RL (W119)

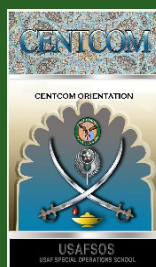

(U) Intercultural Skills for Engagement (C211)

Dates: 18-22 Apr, 16-20 May, 6-10 Jun, 11-15 Jul, 22-26 Aug

Duration: 5 days

Audience: Any AF/SOF dealing with non-DOD partners

Description: builds general knowledge and skills to quickly and accurately comprehend, then appropriately and effectively act, in a culturally complex military mission environment to achieve the desired effect.



(U) INDOPACOM Orientation – RL (T129) & F2F (T228)

Dates: **T129:** 18-21 Apr, 31 May-3 Jun, 18-21 Jul, 29 Aug-1 Sep

T228: 6-10 June, 13-16 Jun, 19-23 Sep

Duration: 4 days (T129), 5 days (T228)

Audience: SOF personnel who support operations in INDOPACOM AOR

Description: Focuses on US strategic interests, as well as theater history and culture.



(U) Negotiate (C231)

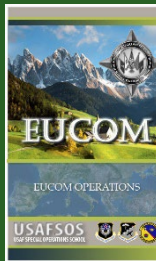
Dates: 23-25 May, 13-15 Jun, 18-20 Jul, 29-31 Aug

Duration: 3 days

Audience: CAA, NSAv, and any AF/SOF dealing with non-DOD partners

Prerequisite: C211 ENGAGE

Description: Designed to meet the negotiation skills requirements of AF/SOC operators in culturally complex, joint, combined, and multi-agency environments that are characterized by varying degrees of competing interests/conflict.



(U) EUCOM Orientation – RL (T139) & F2F (T238)

Dates: **T139:** 2-5 May, 6-9 Jun, 8-11 Aug, 6-9 Sep

T238: 11-15 Jul

Duration: 4 days (T139), 5 days (T238)

Audience: SOF personnel who support operations in EUCOM AOR

Description: Focuses on US strategic interests as well as theater history and culture.



(U) SOF Antiterrorism Officer Level II (FP200)

Dates: 4-8 Apr, 9-13 May, 6-10 Jun, 21-24 Jun, 11-15 Jul, 15-19 Aug.

Duration: 5 Days

Audience: Military officers (O-1 to O-4), enlisted (E-5 to E-8), US Government civilian employees designated by the commander to perform Antiterrorism (AT) duties and other individuals involved in or supporting AT/Force Protection (FP) programs.

Description: The course is designed to provide students with knowledge and appreciation of the organization, motivation, operational capabilities, and threat posed by terrorists on an international, national, and theater specific basis.



(U) AFRICOM Orientation – RL (T149) & F2F (T248)

Dates: **T149:** 4-7 Apr, 11-14 Jul, 26-29 Sep

T248: 13-16 Jun, 1-5 Aug

Duration: 4 days (T149), 5 days (T248)

Audience: SOF personnel who support operations in the AFRICOM AOR

Description: Focuses on US strategic interests, as well as theater history and culture.



(U) SOUTH/NORTHCOM Orientation-RL (T159) & F2F (T258)

Dates: **T159:** 2-5 May, 13-16 Jun, 11-14 Jul, 6-9 Sept

T258: 8-12 Aug

Duration: 4 days (T159), 5 days (T258)

Audience: SOF personnel who support operations in the SOUTHCOM and NORTHCOM AORs

Description: Focuses on US strategic interests in both AORs grounded in cultural and historical knowledge of both theaters.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Remote Learning (RL)?

Remote learning takes place online and utilizes cloud-enabled technology to deliver education. Flexible schedules allow students learn at their own pace through self-directed activities and assignments, and live web-based discussions offer the opportunity for students to interact with their peers and instructors from the convenience of their own homes.

What is On-Demand Remote Learning?

On-demand learning utilizes the same cloud-based infrastructure as remote learning to accommodate the immediate need for education. Self-paced lessons and a wide variety of resources are easily accessible and available 24/7.

What is Face-2-Face (F2F) Learning?

Face-to-face is the traditional method of instruction where students attend a course at a brick and mortar school.

What do I need to take RL courses?

Register for the courses via <https://afsoc.blackboard.com/>

Most of our content is accessible from either government or commercial Internet. To join live web-based sessions or view YouTube videos, commercial internet is required. You will need a device (laptop, smartphone, desktop, tablet) with a microphone and a camera.

What systems does USAFSOS use for RL?

USAFSOS's primary learning management system is Blackboard Learn and the full suite of complementary tools and programs to include Blackboard Collaborate. The Blackboard Collaborate platform offers an immersive educational experience and human interaction through live web-based instruction from your personal device.
